## ■ AIFMD REPORTING – DESCRIPTION OF FEEDBACK FILES AND CONTROLS PERFORMED ON THE REPORTING FILES

The CSSF published today <u>document</u><sup>1</sup> that describes the different feedback files that the senders of the AIFM reporting are receiving. It also describes the controls that the CSSF performs on the reporting files.

Every AIFM and technical agent must receive at least three positive feedback files until all control checks are performed adequately. This does not exclude that the CSSF might contact the AIFM again at a further stage in relation with the content of the reporting file(s).

In case the AIFM or the technical agent encounters problems with feedback files and/or error messages, it is invited to report these to its service provider and/or contact the CSSF by sending an email exclusively to <a href="mailto:aifm@cssf.lu">aifm@cssf.lu</a>.

The above mentioned document will be updated regularly on the basis of exchanges on problems encountered.
