Re: restrictive measures in respect of Zimbabwe

Ladies and Gentlemen,

We are pleased to inform you of the publication of Commission Regulation (EC) No 236/2007 of 2 March 2007 amending Council Regulation (EC) No 314/2004 concerning certain restrictive measures in respect of Zimbabwe.

The purpose of the new Regulation is to amend Annexe III to Regulation (EC) No 314/2004 which lists the persons to whom the freezing of funds and economic resources applies.

Regulation (EC) No 236/2007 entered into force on the day of its publication in the [Official Journal of the European Union No L 66, pages 14-16](#), of 6 March 2007. The Regulation is binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

We remind you that you are required to report immediately any relevant information relating to this Regulation to the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier, which will forward the information to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Immigration, Division of International Economic Relations, as well as to the Ministry of Finance.
