We are pleased to inform you of the publication of Commission Regulation (EC) No 385/2008 of 29 April 2008 amending Council Regulation (EC) No 194/2008 renewing and strengthening the restrictive measures in respect of Burma/Myanmar and repealing Regulation (EC) No 817/2006.

The purpose of this new Regulation is to amend the list of persons, groups and entities to which financial restrictive measures apply and which is included in Annexes VI and VII to Regulation (EC) No 194/2008.

The Regulation entered into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union No L 116, pages 5-16 of 30 April 2008. It is binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
