Ladies and Gentlemen,

We are pleased to inform you of the publication of Commission Regulation (EC) No 895/2008 of 12 September 2008 amending, for the thirteenth time, Regulation (EC) No 1763/2004 imposing certain restrictive measures in support of effective implementation of the mandate of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY).

The purpose of this new Regulation is the amendment of Annex I to the abovementioned Regulation (EC) No 1763/2004, which lists the persons to whom the freezing of funds and economic resources should apply. The following person shall be removed from this Annex: **Radovan KARADZIC**.

Regulation (EC) No 895/2008 shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States. The Regulation entered into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union No L 247, page 19 of 16 September 2008.

This amendment comes with Council Decision 2008/733/CFSP of 15 September 2008 implementing Common Position 2004/694/CFSP on further measures in support of the implementation of the mandate of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY). The Decision entered into force on 15 September 2008, date of its adoption, and was published in the Official Journal of the European Union No L 247, page 63 on 16 September 2008.
