We are pleased to inform you of the publication of Commission Regulation (EC) No 835/2009 of 11 September 2009 amending Council Regulation (EC) No 872/2004 concerning further restrictive measures in relation to Liberia.

The purpose of this Regulation is to replace an entry of Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 872/2004, which lists the natural persons to whom the freezing of funds and economic resources should apply.

The Regulation entered into force on the third day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union No L 241, pages 5-6, of 12 September 2009.

We remind you that you are required to immediately report any relevant information relating to this Regulation to the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier, which will forward the information to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Division of International Economic Relations, as well as to the Ministry of Finance.
