Banks' balance sheet total almost unchanged as at 30 April 2006

As at 30 April 2006, the balance sheet total of the banks established in Luxembourg reached EUR 829.93 billion as compared to EUR 823.03 billion as at 31 March 2006, which is an increase of 0.84%.

Following the withdrawal from the official list of Alcor Bank Luxembourg and Deutsche Postbank AG, Bonn (Germany), succursale de Luxembourg and the registration of NORD/LB COVERED FINANCE BANK S.A., succursale de Luxembourg, the number of banks registered on the official list as at 31 May 2006 reached 152 entities.

■ PROFESSIONALS OF THE FINANCIAL SECTOR (PFS)

Increase in the PFS' balance sheet total as at 30 April 2006

The **balance sheet total** of all the PFS (191 active businesses) as at 30 April 2006 amounted to EUR 64.219 billion as against EUR 60.219 billion in the previous month, which represents a 6.64 % increase over a period of one month.

Provisional net profit of these 191 entities reached EUR 162.6 million at the end of April 2006.

The breakdown of this provisional result by PFS categories shows that the distributors of units/shares of investment funds (35 entities) recorded a total result of EUR 54.5 million at that date. Total result of the professional custodians of securities or other financial instruments (3 entities) reached EUR 50.7 million as at 30 April 2006.


■ UNDERTAKINGS FOR COLLECTIVE INVESTMENT

Increase in UCIs' total net assets at the end of April 2006

As at 30 April 2006, total net assets of undertakings for collective investment reached EUR 1,702.239 billion compared to EUR 1,675.260 billion as at 31 March 2006. The Luxembourg undertakings for collective investment sector increased by 1.61% compared to March 2006. This growth is mainly due to the inflow of new capital. In April 2006, the sector increased by 11.61% compared to 31 December 2005 when the total net assets amounted to EUR 1,525.208 billion. Over the last twelve months, the volume of net assets rose by 42.19%.

During the month of April 2006, net capital investment amounted to EUR 29.196 billion. Compared to 31 December 2005, net capital investment totals EUR 135.765 billion.

The number of undertakings for collective investment taken into consideration totals 2,103 as against 2,091 in the previous month. A total of 1,325 UCIs have adopted the multiple compartment structure, which represents 8,004 compartments. When adding 778 UCIs with a traditional structure to the previous figure, a total of 8,782 compartments are active in the financial centre.

Following these approvals, the number of management companies governed by chapter 13 of the law of 20 December 2002 concerning undertakings for collective investment and allowed to benefit from the European passport since 13 February 2004 by way of free establishment or free provision of services in a EU Member State amounts to 123 as at 12 June 2006.
