BANKS

Banks' balance sheet total almost unchanged as at 31 August 2007

As at 31 August 2007, the balance sheet total of the banks established in Luxembourg reached EUR 888.175 billion as compared to EUR 887.135 billion as at 31 July 2007, which is an increase of 0.1%.

Following the registration on the official list of **PFPC Bank Limited, Luxembourg Branch** and the merger of **BPU Banca International S.A.** with UBI Banca International S.A., the number of banks registered on the official list as at 1 October 2007 remained unchanged at 157 entities.

PROFESSIONALS OF THE FINANCIAL SECTOR (PFS)

Positive development of PFS as at 31 August 2007

The <u>balance sheet total</u> of all the PFS amounted to EUR 117.724 billion as at 31 August 2007 (216 active businesses) against EUR 117.645 billion in the previous month (216 active businesses), which represents a 0.07 % growth over one month.

Provisional net profit of these 216 financial players reached EUR 500.48 million as at 31 August 2007 against EUR 369.62 million as at 31 July 2007 (216 active businesses). Over a period of twelve months, provisional net profit of all PFS rose from EUR 384.68 million as at 31 August 2006 (198 active businesses) to EUR 500.48 million as at 31 August 2007, i.e. an increase of 30.1 % over one year.

The breakdown of this provisional result as at 31 August 2007 by PFS categories shows that the professional custodians of securities or financial instruments (3 entities) recorded a total result of EUR 239.42 million (EUR 179.05 million as at 31 August 2006). The total result of the distributors of units/shares of investment funds (37 entities) reached EUR 119.02 million as at 31 August 2007 (EUR 98.92 million as at 31 August 2006, 33 entities).

PENSION FUNDS, SICARS AND AUTHORISED SECURITISATION UNDERTAKINGS

Authorisation of three new investment companies in risk capital (SICARs)

Since the publication of the last newsletter, three new <u>investment companies in risk capital</u> (SICARs) have been registered on the official list of SICAR's governed by the law of 15 June 2004.

The newly authorised entities are:

- CETP II Participations S.à r.l. Sicar;
- CEP III Participations S.à r.l. Sicar;
- Responsability BOP Investments S.C.A. Sicar.

The following SICAR has been withdrawn from the official list:

- AWL Private Equity OP Sicar S.A..

The number of SICARs registered on the official list amounted to 157 entities as at 9 October 2007.

Following the registration of Levade S.A., the number of <u>securitisation undertakings</u> authorised by the CSSF in accordance with the law of 22 March 2004 on securitisation amounted to 15 entities as at 9 October 2007 as compared to 11 entities as at 31 December 2006.

As at 30 September 2007, 14 <u>pension funds</u> in the form of pension savings companies with variable capital (sepcav) and pension savings associations (assep) were registered on the official list of pension funds subject to the law of 13 July 2005.

The number of <u>professionals authorised to act as liability managers</u> for pension funds subject to the law of 13 July 2005 amounted to 12 as at 30 September 2007.

■ UNDERTAKINGS FOR COLLECTIVE INVESTMENT AND SPECIALISED INVESTMENT FUNDS AT THE END OF AUGUST 2007


I. Overall situation

As at 31 August 2007, total net assets of undertakings for collective investment and specialised investment funds reached EUR 2,035.294 billion compared to EUR 2,052.977 billion as at 31 July 2007, i.e. a 0.86% decrease as compared to the month of July 2007.

This decrease is mainly due to the drop in financial markets following the consequences of the US subprime crisis.

During the month of August 2007, net capital investment amounted to EUR 0.166 billion. Compared to 31 December 2006, net capital investment totalled EUR 154.556 billion.

In August 2007, the sector increased by 10.32% compared to 31 December 2006 when the total net assets amounted to EUR 1,844.850 billion. Over the last twelve months, the volume of net assets rose by 19.20%.



The number of undertakings for collective investment (UCIs) and specialised investment funds (SIFs) taken into consideration totalled 2,460 as against 2,407 in the previous month. A total of 1,518 entities have adopted an umbrella structure, which represents 9,394 sub-funds. When adding the 942 entities with a traditional structure to the previous figure, a total of 10,336 sub-funds are active in the financial centre.

II. Breakdown of UCIs according to Parts I and II of the 2002 law and SIFs

The table above shows that net assets of Part II UCIs, and of SIFs continuously increased during the first eight months of 2007. Net assets of Part I UCIs, on the other hand, decreased by 1.6% as compared to July 2007, due to the drop in financial markets and a net disinvestment.

MANAGEMENT COMPANIES

Approval of a new management company under chapter 13 of the law of 20 December 2002 concerning undertakings for collective investment

The CSSF informs that a new management company has been registered on the official list of management companies governed by chapter 13 of the law of 20 December 2002 concerning undertakings for collective investment, namely:

- Leonardo Asset Management, which is exclusively active in the field of collective management.

Following this approval, the number of management companies governed by chapter 13 of the law of 20 December 2002 concerning undertakings for collective investment and allowed to benefit from the European passport since 13 February 2004 by way of free establishment or free provision of services in a EU Member State amounts to 176 as at 9 October 2007.

Circular CSSF 07/319:

A. New prudential reporting scheme regarding capital adequacy (tables B 1.4 and B 6.4)

B. New prudential financial reporting scheme (tables B 1.1, B 1.6, B 2.1, B 2.5 and B 6.1, B 6.6, B 6.2, B 6.7)

Circular CSSF 07/319 updates the parts of the *Recueil des instructions aux banques* relating to tables B 1.4 and B 6.4. This update had become necessary due to the adoption of the new prudential reporting scheme regarding capital adequacy applicable from 1 January 2008.

Moreover, the circular specifies the technical aspects relating to the new prudential reporting scheme regarding capital adequacy, i.e. tables B 1.4 and B 6.4, as well as the new prudential financial reporting scheme, i.e. tables B 1.1, B 1.6, B 2.1, B 2.5 and B 6.1, B 6.6, B 6.2, B 6.7. The circular provides the technical documentation (Schedule of conditions) relating to the new prudential reporting scheme applicable on an individual and consolidated basis, as well as an XBRL taxonomy relating to the new prudential tables.
